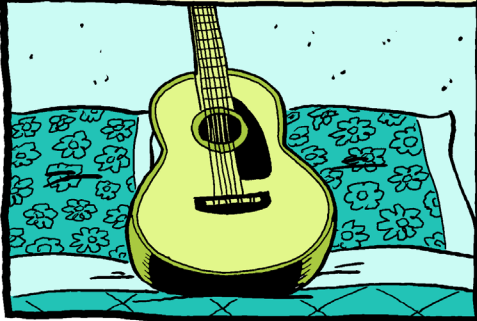

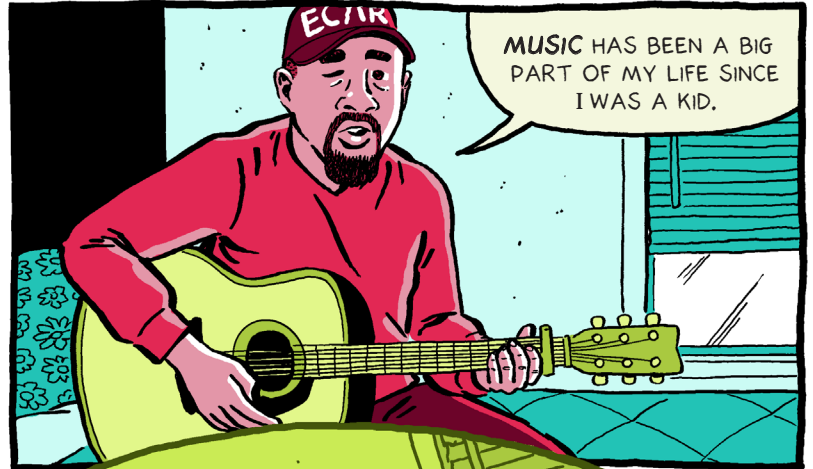

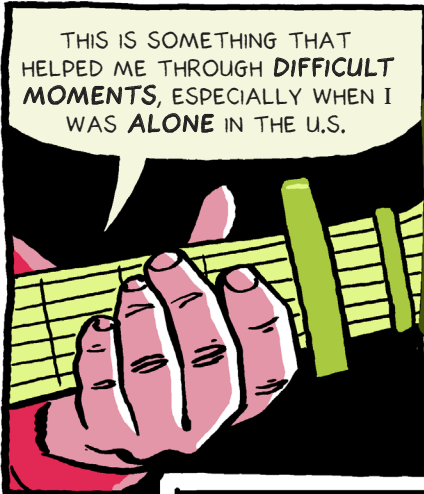

SO IT'S LIKE A CURE -- MY HEART'S CURE.

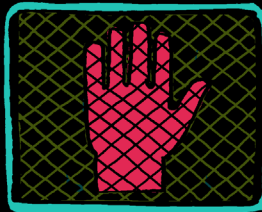


THE FIRST FEW DAYS IN THE U.S., I WAS LOST.
